Environment & Energy Congressional Round-Up | April 24 - April 28, 2023

Highlights:

In the Senate, the *Recycling and Composting Accountability Act* (S.1194) passed out of the Environment and Public Works Committee. The bipartisan bill would direct the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to improve recycling and composting programs through expanded data collection. The *Recycling Infrastructure and Accessibility Act of 2023* (S.1189) also passed out of the Environment and Public Works Committee. That bill would require the EPA to create a pilot grant program to support improved recycling accessibility.

Also in the Senate, Sens. Jeanne Shaheen (D-N.H.) and Shelley Moore Capito (R-W.Va.) introduced the *Forest Incentives Program Act* (S.1366), a bill that would provide incentives for forest managers to adopt conservation practices that reduce emissions, and for commercial building owners to use less emissions-intensive building materials.

On the topic of forestry, Sens. Sherrod Brown (D-Ohio) and Cory Booker (D-N.J.) introduced the *Neighborhood Tree Act of 2023* (S.1380), a bill that would create a <u>neighborhood tree fund</u> for urban tree canopies, prioritizing underserved communities.
