Environment & Energy Congressional Round-Up | April 7 - April 11, 2025

Highlights:

The Senate passed the *Aerial Firefighting Enhancement Act of 2025* (<u>S.160</u>). Sens. Martin Heinrich (D-N.M.) and Tim Sheehy (R-Mont.) introduced the bill to <u>improve</u> aerial <u>wildfire</u> combat through the purchase of excess military aircraft.

The Senate Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation passed the *Save Our Seas 2.0 Amendments Act* (S.216). The bill, led by Sens. Dan Sullivan (R-Ark.) and Sheldon Whitehouse (D-R.I.), aims to strengthen the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA) <u>Marine Debris Program</u>. The program works to accelerate federal response to marine pollution events, increase international cooperation on ocean cleanup, and drive plastic waste reduction and reuse.

Sens. Brian Schatz (D-Hawaii) and Tim Sheehy (R-Mont.) reintroduced the *Transformational Artificial Intelligence to Modernize the Economy (TAME) Extreme Weather and Wildfires Act* (S.1378). If passed, the bill would leverage artificial intelligence (AI) to <u>improve</u> forecasting of and response to wildfires, hurricanes, flooding, and extreme heat. Rep. Scott Franklin (R-Fla.) introduced a similar bill (<u>H.R.2770</u>) to increase the use of AI at NOAA to adapt to extreme weather events.

Sens. Bill Cassidy (R-La.) and Lindsey Graham (R-S.C.) reintroduced the *Foreign Pollution Fee Act* (<u>S.1325</u>). The bill would <u>tax</u> imports of certain high-emissions products such as building materials, fertilizers, and battery components — including an 80-100% tax for the "<u>worst offenders</u>" — while working to revitalize U.S. manufacturing.
