Environment & Energy Congressional Round-Up | February 26 - March 1, 2024

Highlights:

The *Atomic Energy Advancement Act* (<u>H.R.6544</u>) passed the House. Introduced by Reps. Jeff Duncan (R-S.C.) and Diana DeGette (D-Colo.), the bipartisan bill would strengthen licensing and regulatory processes for <u>nuclear energy technologies</u> to accelerate their deployment.

In the House, the *Energy Emergency Leadership Act* (<u>H.R.3277</u>) was reported out of the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and is scheduled for a vote on the House floor. Introduced by Reps. Tim Walberg (R-Mich.) and Lisa Blunt Rochester (D-Del.), this bipartisan bill would sharpen the Department of Energy's focus on addressing <u>cybersecurity issues</u> related to energy infrastructure.

Sens. Mark Kelly (D-Ariz.) and Cynthia Lummis (R-Wyo.) introduced the *Legacy Mine Cleanup Act of 2024* (<u>S.3858</u>). The bipartisan bill aims to strengthen remediation efforts for hazardous abandoned hardrock mines by establishing a new Office of Mountains, Deserts, and Plains within the Environmental Protection Agency, and increasing federal funding—and access to that funding—for cleanup efforts.
