Environment & Energy Congressional Round-Up | January 6, 2025 - January 10, 2025

Highlights:

Rep. David Joyce (R-Ohio), alongside Reps. Debbie Dingell (D-Mich.), Bill Huizenga (R-Mich.), and Marcy Kaptur (D-Ohio) reintroduced the *Great Lakes Restoration Initiative (GLRI) Act of 2025* (H.R.284). The GLRI <u>supports</u> Great Lakes states, tribes, and communities with funding for projects that address issues like habitat loss, agricultural water pollution, and invasive species. The bill would provide an annual \$500 million for the program over five years.

Reps. Nick LaLota (R-N.Y.) and Joe Courtney (D-Conn.) reintroduced the *Long Island Sound Stewardship and Restoration Act* (H.R.288). If passed, the bill would reauthorize the Environmental Protection Agency's Long Island Sound programs for five years, and support the development of new conservation programs for 12 priority habitats in the region.
