# Environment & Energy Congressional Round-Up | September 9 - September 13, 2024

# Highlights:

The House Natural Resources Committee advanced the *Coastal Habitat Conservation Act of 2023* (H.R.2950) to the House floor. Reps. Jared Huffman (D-Calif.), Ranking Member of the Natural Resources Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries, and Jenniffer González-Colón (R-P.R.) lead the bill, which <u>reauthorizes</u> federal programming to bolster the health and resilience of coastal habitats. The Senate Committee on Environment and Public Works passed its companion bill (<u>S.1381</u>) in July.

The House Natural Resources Committee <u>passed</u> the *Fix Our Forests Act* (<u>H.R.8790</u>) to increase wildfire resilience of federally managed forests, among <u>other initiatives</u>. Introduced by Natural Resources Committee Chairman Bruce Westerman (R-Ark.) and Rep. Scott Peters (D-Calif.), the bill will progress to the House floor for a vote.

Sens. John Hickenlooper (D-Colo.) and Jerry Moran (R-Kansas) and Reps. Brittany Pettersen (D-Colo.) and Juan Ciscomani (R-Ariz.) introduced the *Water Project Navigators Act* (<u>S.4995/H.R.9506</u>) to connect drought-impacted communities with federal resources to boost resilience and recovery.

Sen. Sherrod Brown (D-Ohio) and Rep. Greg Casar (D-Texas), alongside Democratic cosponsors, introduced the *American Energy Worker Opportunity Act* (S.5034/H.R.9557). The bill would establish a <u>workforce transition program</u> to provide wage replacement, healthcare, education, and training benefits to fossil fuel workers impacted by the clean energy transition.
