# **Environment & Energy Congressional Round-Up | May 9-13, 2022**

## Highlights:

The bipartisan Providing Research and Estimates of Changes in Precipitation (PRECIP) Act (S.3053/H.R.1437) passed the House. The bill aims to **update National Oceanic** and Atmospheric Administration precipitation data to better inform zoning decisions and help communities prepare for climate impacts like flooding. The bipartisan American Fisheries Advisory Committee Act (P.L. 117-121) became law. The law establishes an advisory committee to assist in the awarding of fisheries research and development grants.
