Environment & Energy Congressional Round-Up | July 18 - 22

Highlights:

This week, several new bills focused on studying wildfires and improving wildfire management. The *Fire Ready Nation Act of 2022* (H.R. 8449), introduced in the House, would create a program within the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to improve wildfire forecasting, detection, modeling and observations. <u>H.R. 8483</u>, which would require studies on insurance coverage for wildfire damage, was also introduced in the House this week. Check out EESI's briefing *Living with Climate Change: Wildfires* for a deep dive into policies and practices to reduce wildfire risk in the United States.

The 2023 appropriations bill for the Department of Transportation and Department of Housing and Urban Development, <u>H.R.8294</u>, passed the House.

The House Agriculture Committee held a <u>hearing</u> on stakeholder perspectives of the crop insurance title of the farm bill.
