Environment & Energy Congressional Round-Up | May 15 - May 19, 2023

Highlights:

Rep. Sean Casten (D-III.), Rep. Elissa Slotkin (D-Mich.), Sen. Sherrod Brown (D-Ohio), and Rep. Mike Bost (R-III.) reintroduced the *Conservation Opportunity and Voluntary Environment Resilience Program (COVER) Act* (H.R.3478/S.1690), a bipartisan bill that would provide a crop insurance discount to farmers choosing to plant cover crops. EESI's resources discuss the provisions of last year's *COVER Act* and the benefits of cover crops for climate change mitigation and adaptation.

The *EVs for All Act* (<u>H.R.3468/S.1704</u>) was reintroduced in both houses with support from 24 cosponsors. The bill would develop a grant program to <u>support</u> electric vehicle car sharing at public housing projects.

Sen. Martin Heinrich (D-N.Mex.) and Sen. Ben Ray Lujan (D-N.Mex.) reintroduced the *M.H. Dutch Salmon Greater Gila Wild and Scenic River Act* (S.776), which follows the House version of the bill introduced last month, <u>H.R.1611</u>. The bill would designate portions of the river as "Wild and Scenic," which would prevent them from being dammed or diverted. EESI's <u>article</u>, "Keeping the Gila River Wild for People and the Planet," dives deeper into the importance of this designation for the Gila.

The House Committee on Agriculture held a <u>hearing</u> to review the national forest system, with a focus on managing wildfires and supporting forest health. EESI tracks the climate, environment, and energy highlights of all the 2023 Farm Bill hearings <u>here</u>.
